I acknowledge that I have been advised to consult legal counsel and have had the opportunity to consult with legal counsel prior to entering into the Indemnification / Hold Harmless / Release of Liability Agreement.

I understand and agree that, by signing this Indemnification / Hold Harmless / Release of Liability Agreement, that I relinquish all rights or claims to adjudication or recourse which I may be entitled to in relation to any damages or injury that may arise out of the above described activities.

I warrant that I enter into this agreement with full knowledge of the meaning and future effects of the promises, releases and waivers contained herein.

I warrant that I have entered into the releases and waivers contained in this Agreement voluntarily and that I make them without any duress or undue influence of any nature by any person.

# La Verkin City Winter Fest Soap Box Derby

## Participation Rules

1. Good Sportsmanlike conduct is expected from everyone involved.
2. All soapboxes must be gravity powered, meaning no engines or external energy sources are allowed.
3. All vehicles must have no more than four and no less than three wheels on the ground
4. All drivers must sign the waiver and release from liability, for drivers under 18 years of age, a parent or guardian must sign for them.
5. All drivers must wear a helmet. Please do not alter or make your own helmet. Elbow pads are also strongly encouraged.
6. The steering system has to pass inspection of the Race Director. All sharp edges need to be covered for the Participants protection.
7. Racers must be equipped with a brake capable of stopping the racer in a safe distance.
8. A driver will be disqualified in a race in which he allows his tires to cross the center line of cones. The FIRST DRIVER to allow his tires to cross the line is disqualified and the race is over. This can be decided by the starter judge, midway judge or the finish judge. All Judges Decisions will be final.
9. If, for any reason, a race is declared null and void by the Race Director, the race will be re-run.
  - a. If a malfunction occurs in a racer after the race has started, the race will not be re-run unless the wheels cause the problem.
10. Each participant must wear their safety helmet. Failure to wear a helmet will result in the forfeiture of the first race. The racer must supply their helmet.
  - a. Goggles or safety glasses that do not obstruct the driver's vision will be permitted.
11. The entry fee of \$20 per Participant must be included with the registration form and be turned in to the La Verkin City Office by November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Each Participant that registers will receive a 2014 Winter Fest Soap Box Race T-shirt. Participants registered after the cut-off dates will pay a late registration fee of \$25 and are not guaranteed a shirt that is the right size.
12. No vulgar language will be tolerated at any time during the race. A warning will be given after the first offense and ejection will take place after the second.
13. No alcohol is allowed anywhere during the practices or the race.
14. Any questions, concerns, etc. should be brought to the attention of the race director.
